**A RESOLUTION TO ERECT REGULATORY SPEED  
SIGNS IN RURAL RESIDENTIAL DISTRICTS**

**WHEREAS**, Minn. Stat. § 169.14, subd. 2(a)(1) establishes a 30 m.p.h. speed limit on town roads in rural residential districts;

**WHEREAS**, a “rural residential district” is defined in Minn. Stat. ' 169.14, subd. 2(c) as “the territory contiguous to and including any town road within a subdivision or plat of land that is built up with dwelling houses at intervals of less than 300 feet for a distance of one-quarter mile or more”;

**WHEREAS**, the town board has determined, as a result of on-site inspections, the following roads are within a rural residential district as defined above:

**Island Lake Road**

**Big Fish Lake Road**

**Kepler Court**

**Schultz Road**

**Hidden Cove Road**

**Theresia Terrace Road**

**WHEREAS**, as town roads within a rural residential district the legislature has established the speed limit to be 30 m.p.h. without the need for a speed study by the Minnesota Department of Transportation;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the town board of Colleeville Township, Stearns County, Minnesota that 30 m.p.h. regulatory speed limit signs be erected on the above described roads in accordance with the Minnesota Uniform Manual on Traffic Control Devices.
