

**Additional Board of Supervisors Meeting**  
**June 15, 2016**  
**Minutes**

On Wednesday, June 15, 2016 the Collegeville Board of Supervisors met for an additional Board meeting at the Collegeville Township Hall. Present were Supervisor Guggenberger, chair, Supervisor Kron, vice-chair, Supervisor Thompson, Treasurer Simon and Clerk Pohl. The meeting was called to order at 7:00pm by Supervisor Guggenberger.

The Board reviewed the presented agenda. Supervisor Kron motioned to approve agenda, seconded by Supervisor Thompson, motion carried.

Brian Schultz, civil engineer, was present to share and discuss his findings for road conditions of Fruit Farm Rd, Theresia Terrace Rd, Hollyhock Rd, 270<sup>th</sup> Street, and Kreigle Lake Rd. Supervisor Kron motioned for Brian to get a quote for soil borings on all five roads and construction documents for Theresia Terrace Rd, seconded by Supervisor Thompson, motion carried.

July 26<sup>th</sup> meeting will be moved to July 28<sup>th</sup> at 7:00pm.

Jim Sand from Big Fish Lake Association was present to request the use of the Town Hall parking lot to stage a Stearns County aquatic invasive species decontamination unit for the 2016 boating season. Supervisor Kron motioned to approve staging of unit on the property west of County Rd 50, seconded by Supervisor Thompson, motion carried.

The Board discussed a request from a resident on Jennifer Drive to blade the gravel portion of the road. Supervisors determined not to pursue this because it's a private road.

Ditch mowing was discussed. Maintenance Operators will start on this.

Supervisor Thompson gave an update on a weed inspection he did with Ron and Doug on various roads in the Township.

Final numbers for Township Cleanup Day were reviewed. 54 customers with approximately \$1300 in receipts.

Supervisor Kron motioned to adjourn at 8:31pm, seconded by Supervisor Thompson, motion carried.
