

Collegeville Township Annual Meeting Minutes for 2012

On Tuesday, March 13, 2012 Collegeville Township held it's annual meeting at the Town Hall. The meeting was called to order by Deputy Clerk Karen Kmitch at 8:00pm.

Deputy Clerk Kmitch lead the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Allen Eisenschenk nominated Bob Simon as the meeting moderator, seconded by Bill Fahrney, motion carried.

Deputy Clerk Kmitch read the minutes from the 2011 annual meeting. Arnie Hamann motioned to approve the minutes as read, seconded by Bonnie Thompson, motion carried.

Moderator Simon presented the year-end financial report. Total balance of all funds at the end of 2011 was \$463,965.86. John Hooper motioned to approve the financial report, seconded by Bonnie Thompson, motion carried.

Moderator Simon presented the proposed Levy for taxes payable in 2013.

Proposed 2012 and 2013 road projects were reviewed.

Dan Weber, Fire Chief from Cold Spring presented update. There were 340 calls for 2011, 19 of them were in Collegeville. There were two grants received last year - one for firefighter training, and another from Stearns Electric. They currently have 29 firefighters with permission to hire one more. The Fire Fest fundraiser will be July 28th.

John Hooper motioned to retain the Cold Spring Record and the Township Website as the official posting methods, Allen Schmitz seconded, motion carried.

Galen Kabe motioned to keep the poll hours from 1:00pm to 8:00pm for the 2013 Annual Election, seconded by John Hooper, motion carried.

Bill Fahrney advised us that Linus Heinen was presented with a LifeTime Service Award by the Avon Hills Initiative.

Township Cleanup Day will be discussed further, no date set at this time.
