

Collegeville Township Annual Meeting Minutes for 2014

On Tuesday, March 11, 2014 Collegeville Township held its annual meeting at the Town Hall. The meeting was called to order by Clerk Joe Pohl at 8:07pm.

Allan Eisenschenk nominated Mary Eisenschenk as the meeting moderator, seconded by Bob Thompson, motion carried.

Clerk Pohl read the minutes from the 2013 annual meeting. Dan Kron motioned to approve the minutes as read, seconded by Jim Eisenschenk, motion carried.

Clerk Pohl presented the year-end financial reports. Total balance of all funds at the end of 2013 was \$545,942.16. John Hooper motioned to approve the financial report, seconded by Linus Heinen, motion carried.

Supervisor Bill Fahrney presented information on the Island Lake Road reconstruction project. Various questions related to the project were answered by the Town Board and Engineer Mike Nelson.

Clerk Pohl presented the proposed Levy for taxes payable in 2015.

John Hooper motioned to authorize the Town Board to expend funds (up to \$500) from the General Revenue fund to recognize volunteers and special service efforts, seconded by Dan Kron, motion carried.
