Monthly Board of Supervisors Meeting

August 2020

On Tuesday, August 25, 2020 the Collegeville Board of Supervisors met for their monthly at the Town Hall. The meeting was called to order at 7:00pm by Supervisor Guggenberger. Present were Supervisor Craig Guggenberger - Chair, Supervisor Terry Stein, Treasurer Bob Simon and Clerk Joe Pohl.

The Board reviewed the presented agenda. Supervisor Stein motioned to approve the agenda, seconded by Supervisor Guggenberger, motion carried 2-0.

The Board reviewed the July 2020 Board of Supervisors Meeting minutes. Supervisor Stein motioned to approve the minutes as submitted, seconded by Supervisor Guggenberger, motion carried 2-0.

Payroll and claims for the month were reviewed. Supervisor Guggenberger motioned to approve check numbers 13668-13709, for a total of \$84,546.74, seconded by Supervisor Stein, motion carried 2-0.

Supervisors reviewed the Treasurer's Report. Balance for all accounts is \$458,363.34. Supervisor Stein motioned to approve the Treasurer's Report, seconded by Supervisor Guggenberger, motion carried 2-0.

Ordinance Administrator Allan Eisenschenk presented the Planning Commission Report.

1. Shawn and Josie Judes – Request for a Letter of Compliance to split into Tract A (3.00 acres) and Tract B (4.15 acres) for parcel id 05.02655.0000. Tract A will retain parcel id 05.02655.0000 and Tract B will get a new parcel id. Supervisor Guggenberger motioned to approve as recommended by the Planning Commission, seconded by Supervisor Stein, motion carried 2-0.

Wes Davis from Bogart Pederson Engineering was present to review their proposal for design and construction for the 287th Street and Kalla Lake Road projects. Supervisor Guggenberger motioned for Bogart Pederson to start on the design phase for both projects, seconded by Supervisor Stein, motion carried 2-0. Supervisor Guggenberger motioned to contract with Omalley Kron for surveying purposes for both road projects, seconded by Supervisor Stein, motion carried 2-0.

3. Ralph Doubek – Application for Construction Site Permit for a 30' x 45' accessory building for personal storage at 18506 260th St. Supervisor Guggenberger motioned to approve as recommended by the Planning Commission, seconded by Supervisor Stein, motion carried 2-0.
4. Brad and Gina Dullinger – Application for Construction Site Permit for a 36' x 70.2' x 44' high agricultural accessory building at 15552 County Rd 51. Supervisor Stein motioned to approve as recommended by the Planning Commission, seconded by Supervisor Guggenberger, motion carried 2-0.

Tree just off of Hidden Cove Road needs to be removed. Treasurer Simon will work with contractor on this.

Supervisor Guggenberger motioned to adjourn at 8:18pm, seconded by Supervisor Stein.
