Monthly Board of Supervisors Meeting

May 28, 2019

On Tuesday, May 28, 2019 the Collegeville Board of Supervisors met for their monthly meeting at the Collegeville Township Hall. Present were Supervisor Terry Stein, Chair, Supervisor Craig Guggenberger, Vice Chair, Supervisor Rick Thompson, Treasurer Bob Simon and Clerk Joe Pohl. The meeting was called to order at 7:00pm by Supervisor Stein.

The Board reviewed the presented agenda. Supervisor Guggenberger motioned to approve the agenda, seconded by Supervisor Thompson, motioned carried 3-0.

The Board reviewed the April 2019 Board of Supervisors Meeting minutes. Supervisor Thompson motioned to approve the minutes as submitted, seconded by Supervisor Guggenberger, motion carried 3-0.

The Board reviewed the May 15, 2019 Additional Board Meeting minutes. Supervisor Guggenberger motioned to approve the minutes as submitted, seconded by Supervisor Thompson, motion carried 3-0.

Payroll and claims for the month were reviewed. Supervisor Thompson motioned to approve check numbers 13215-13241, for a total of \$23,397.65 voiding check number 13234 for \$81.00, seconded by Supervisor Guggenberger, motion carried 3-0.

Stearns County Deputy Jamie Florek was present to introduce himself as the liaison for the Sheriff's Department and the Township.

Supervisors reviewed the Treasurer's Report. Balance for all accounts is \$155,293.27. Supervisor Guggenberger motioned to approve the Treasurer's Report, seconded by Supervisor Thompson, motion carried 3-0.

Ordinance Administrator Allan Eisenschenk presented the Planning Commission Report.

1. Ed and Catherine Laubach – Application for Approach Permit at 26954 Theresia Terrace Rd. Supervisor Guggenberger motioned to approve under condition that a 15" culvert is used and the existing driveway be removed, seconded by Supervisor Thompson, motion carried 3-0.
2. Anthony & Debra Vorderbruggen – Application for Construction Site Permit for a new house and attached garage at 28829 Ladyslipper Court. Supervisor Guggenberger motioned to approve as recommended by the Planning Commission, seconded by Supervisor Thompson, motion carried 3-0.
3. Dan and Dana Rea – Application for Construction Site Permit for a 30' x 42' Accessory Building at 18513 Rosemary Lane. Supervisor Guggenberger motioned to approve as recommended by the Planning Commission, seconded by Supervisor Thompson, motion carried 3-0.
4. Jeremy Fleck - Application for Construction Site Permit for a 60' x 80' Accessory Building at 16633 277th Street. Supervisor Thompson motioned to approve as recommended by the Planning Commission, seconded by Supervisor Guggenberger, motion carried 3-0.
5. Brandon Dingmann – Stearns County Permit Application for an Animal Feedlot or Manure Storage Area at 13954 262nd Street, Cold Spring, MN. Supervisor Thompson motioned to approve, seconded by Supervisor Guggenberger, motion carried 3-0.

Discussions were made on road work done 177th Ave. Maintenance Operator Ron Blum was reminded not to do work on that road or other roads unless he is given direction by a Supervisor. Supervisor Thompson will follow-up on how/what corrections can be made to the road.

Supervisor Guggenberger gave an update on a hole on Theresia Terrace Rd.

A culvert with a gas line next to it on Fruit Farm Road needs to be replaced. Supervisor Guggenberger will follow-up on this. Center Point Energy has agreed to cover the cost of replacing this culvert and will need to be billed once the project is done.

Supervisor Guggenberger will get pricing on gravel.
