Monthly Board of Supervisors Meeting

September 2020

On Monday, September 28, 2020 the Collegeville Board of Supervisors met for their monthly at the Town Hall. The meeting was called to order at 7:00pm by Supervisor Guggenberger. Present were Supervisor Craig Guggenberger - Chair, Supervisor Terry Stein, Treasurer Bob Simon and Clerk Joe Pohl.

The Board reviewed the presented agenda. Supervisor Stein motioned to approve the agenda, seconded by Supervisor Guggenberger, motion carried 2-0.

The Board reviewed the August 2020 Board of Supervisors Meeting minutes. Supervisor Stein motioned to approve the minutes as submitted, seconded by Supervisor Guggenberger, motion carried 2-0.

Payroll and claims for the month were reviewed. Supervisor Stein motioned to approve check numbers 13710-13741, for a total of \$46,183.22, seconded by Supervisor Guggenberger, motion carried 2-0.

Supervisors reviewed the Treasurer's Report. Balance for all accounts is \$376,546.13. Supervisor Stein motioned to approve the Treasurer's Report, seconded by Supervisor Guggenberger, motion carried 2-0.

Ordinance Administrator Allan Eisenschenk presented the Planning Commission Report.

1. Paul and Donna Wellenstein - Application for Driveway Approach Permit at 17651 Alexander Point Rd. Supervisor Stein motioned to approve as recommended by the Planning Commission, seconded by Supervisor Guggenberger, motion carried 2-0.

Treasurer Simon gave an update on a tree just off of Hidden Cove Road that needs to be removed.

Clerk Pohl gave an update on a paper box that is on a separate post on Fruit Farm Road. Clerk Pohl will send a letter to the property owner.

Discussions were made on adding a Town logo to equipment.

Discussions were made on vehicles traveling on Maple Lane from County Road 9 to Kreigle Lake Road. Maple Lane on the north end is a private road so no signage will be placed at that end. A dead end road sign will be placed on the south end at that portion is maintained by the Township.

Township Cleanup Day costs were discussed.

Supervisor Guggenberger motioned to accept the resignation of Supervisor Rick Thompson, seconded by Supervisor Stein, motion carried 2-0.

Supervisor Guggenberger motioned to adjourn at 8:23pm, seconded by Supervisor Stein.
